Idhammar MMS Version 10 provides fresh features and extended functionality including Maintenance Alerts, Resource Planners, Skills Registers, and Active Directory Compliance – everything Maintenance Managers need to ensure professional, compliant maintenance services.

Getting the most appropriate resource to the most important job, in as short a time as possible, is business critical in this day and age. The new version of Idhammar MMS enables Maintenance Managers to respond quickly and effectively, whilst ensuring that all aspects of due diligence can be recorded in the system for easy reporting come audit time. The new features include:

Workload Planning

The workload planner allows you to select a range of related tasks and make checks in order to determine if there are enough materials and labour to undertake a job. It is also able to suggest revised start dates based on resource availability and demand.

Skills Register and Task Management

Idhammar MMS V10 offers a new function that allows the selection of a range of Tasks, checks that there are enough materials and labour to undertake the job, and suggests revised start dates based on the resource availability. Personal Development Records can also be associated with each member of the team, enabling an Enquiry facility within the system to search for personnel who possess a specified skill and a valid certificate to perform the maintenance task.

Segregation of Duties

You can now configure the Idhammar MMS to validate a number of resources in order to ratify that users have the authority to perform purchasing activity, ensuring that:

- The Requisition Creator is not the same resource as the Requisition Authoriser
- The Issuer of a Purchase Order is not the same resource as the Requisition Authoriser
- The Goods Receiver is not the same resource as the PO Issuer
- The Invoice Authoriser is not the same resource as the Goods Receiver.





Other new features added to Idhammar MMS include:

Asset warranty
Stock valuation history
Project costs
Work order attachments
Meter based planning
Overdue deliveries report
Loan Items

Maintenance Alerts

Idhammar MMS can now trigger a range of alerts to the maintenance team – whether that's a group or person in charge of a particular asset, a member of the team allocated to a job, or a Work Order Requester. The following examples of Maintenance Alerts are designed to shorten MTTR:

- Work Order/Task is created
- Actual costs in excess of system value (KPI) is posted
- Work Order/Task is completed
- Work Order/Task completed and downtime exceeds system value (KPI)

Alerts

A number of other Alerts are now a part of the standard system, designed to speed up processes and shorten lead times, including:

- Alert triggered to Authoriser identified on Requisition when requisition requires authorisation
- Alert triggered to Technician (i.e. internal contact) identified on a Purchase Order when items are delivered. The message will include the quantity delivered and the unit of measure
- Alert triggered to Asset Owner three months before warranty expires on an Asset. If the asset owner is a personnel group the alert will be sent to all members of that group
- Alert triggered to Purchase Order Technician (i.e. internal contact) when delivery is overdue
- Alert to borrower of an item when the item is overdue for return
- Alert to Agreement Owner if maximum amount will be exceeded if requisition is processed

Safety, Environmental and Permit to Work Warnings

Symbols indicating Health and Safety, Environmental issues or Permit to Work required are now displayed on the relevant task. Documents and Assets can now be flagged as Health and Safety, Environmental and Permit to Work.

Active Directory Compliance

New and existing users will also benefit from V10 being Active Directory Compliant – meaning that users do not need to 'sign on' to the Idhammar MMS, speeding up the process of entering, searching, sending and reporting on data in the system.
